

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING – CAIRO MAYOR & COUNCIL – SEPTEMBER 30, 2010

The September 30, 2010 Special Called Meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. in the Council Room at 101-B North Broad Street with Mayor Richard VanLandingham presiding. Present were Mayor Pro Tem Lannis Thornton, Council Members James H. Douglas, and Kermit V. Gilliard, Jr. Councilman Robert L. Gwaltney was out of town, and Councilman Ernest W. Cloud, Jr. joined the meeting after the invocation. Staff Members in attendance were City Manager Chris Addleton, City Attorney Thomas L. Lehman, and City Clerk Carolyn B. Lee. Cairo Messenger Reporter Darrell Mudra was also in attendance.

INVOCATION – Mayor VanLandingham gave the Invocation.

SPECIAL BUSINESS:

The meeting was called for the purpose of setting the 2010 final ad valorem tax millage rate. After review, motion was made by Councilman Douglas to set the final millage rate at 7.49 net mills, seconded by Councilman Thornton, and approved by all Council Members present.

Introduction of the 2010 Tax Ordinance. The ordinance was introduced that would provide for setting of the 2010 tax millage rates at 12.47 gross mills, with a local sales tax credit of 4.98 mills, resulting in a net millage rate of 7.49 mills (an amount of which is equal to .25 mills to be set aside for the Fire Truck Fund). Ordinance will be considered for adoption at the October 11th meeting.

ADJOURN: There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
